While most of western and central India receives nearly 90 percent of their annual rainfall quota during this time, the southern and northwestern regions receive between 50-75 percent of their annual quota. With temperatures dropping to as low as 27°C to 35°C in most parts of the country reeling under scorching heat, the monsoon season in India is a welcome relief, even if it does increase humidity.

Best places to visit in India during monsoon

Alleppey, Kerala



Alleppey, everybody's favourite backwaters destination in Kerala, is a sight to behold during monsoons. The backwaters and adjoining villages look even more alluring after a fresh batch of rains that refresh and rejuvenate the area. The light to heavy rains is perfect for cruising along the



backwaters on a covered houseboat, sipping on a hot beverage, and contemplating an assortment of fresh seafood.

Average temperature: 25°C to 31°C

Things to do in Alleppey: Go kayaking on the backwaters, try parasailing on Alleppey Beach,

and attend the Nehru Trophy Boat Race (August 10, 2024)

Nearby hotels: Marari Beach Resort, Warmth Lake Haven, and Sterling Lake Palace Alleppey **Best restaurants:** Cassia Restaurant, Bayroute Bistro, and Dreamers Café and Restaurant
