They must remain in paid quarantine till the test results. ▪ Avoid travel if symptomatic. ▪ Maintain social distancing of 2 meters from everybody throughout their stay in the state and carry sanitizers while travelling. ▪ Put on Face Masks throughout. ▪ Stay away from elderly people and people with morbidity. Persons above 65 years of age, persons with morbidities, pregnant women and children below the age of 10 years are advised to take extra precautions as per MHA guidelines. ▪ Practice hand hygiene at least every half an hour and before and after touching frequently touched surfaces. ▪ Avoid visiting public places / congregations other than the planned purpose of visit and avoid public transport. ▪ All tourists should pre book their stay in hotel. ▪ Tourists to have a pre-arranged specific itinerary for the visit. ▪ Encourage online purchase of entry tickets to National Parks/Wildlife sanctuaries, monuments, etc. ▪ Allotted time slots by any facility/tourist attraction/activity should be followed by all tourists for the convenience of service providers and other tourists. ▪ Tourists should avoid handling cash as much as possible. Payments may be done through digital modes. ▪ Do self-symptom surveillance during their stay in State (Fever, cough, sore throat, diarrhea, loss of smell/taste, fatigue (for smell test-smell coffee and look for alteration in perception of smell)) and contact DISHA 1056 if they develop symptoms and follow health advisory. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. KERALA	Sterling Anaikatti Sterling Guruvayur Sterling Munnar Sterling Rajakkad Sterling Thekkady Sterling Wayanad	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Anybody who develops any of the above-mentioned symptoms (even if mild) to remain in strict isolation. ▪ The domestic tourists who visit the State for more than 7 days have to produce a COVID negative certificate (RTPCR test/Rapid Antigen test within 48 hours prior to arrival from ICMR/State Government approved laboratory) or undergo Rapid Antigen Test/RTPCR Test at cost on arrival in the State from ICMR/State Government approved laboratories and test negative. ▪ The domestic tourists who visit the State for more than 7 days and have not produced the test results of COVID testing within 48 hours prior to the entry or not tested after the entry in Kerala shall undergo 7 days quarantine and can be tested on the 7th day after arrival and if tested negative, further quarantine of 7 days is optional and not mandatory, since 14 days quarantine is desirable as per Health protocol. Those who don't get tested on the 7th day would be advised to continue on quarantine for the remaining 7 days and complete a total of 14 days in quarantine. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. MAHARASHTRA	Sterling Lonavala	<p><u>Domestic Air Travel</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> All domestic passengers travelling from airports in NCR DELHI, States of Rajasthan, Gujarat and Goa shall carry RT_PCR negative test report with them before boarding and show it at the airport. The Airports Authority of India is requested to check for the report before allowing the passengers to board the flight. The RT-PCR sample collection should have been done within 72 hours of scheduled time of landing at Airports in Maharashtra. Passengers NOT having the RT-PCR test reports fulfilling conditions above in 1 and 2, shall compulsorily undergo RT-PCR test at the concerned airports, at their own cost. The Airport shall arrange the testing centres and charge the passengers directly for testing. Only after undertaking the test, the passengers will be allowed to go to their destination by Airport Operator. The Contact information and address shall be collected from all passengers who undergo tests at airport by Airport Operator to facilitate contact, in case the test report comes positive. Passengers whose report comes positive will be contacted and treated as per existing protocol. The concerned Municipal Commissioners will be the Nodal Officers for the same and ensure that the above instructions are followed strictly.

		<p><u>Railways</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All passengers travelling to Maharashtra by trains originating or having halt/stop at stations in the NCR Delhi, States of Rajasthan, Gujarat and Goa shall carry with them RT-PCR negative test report before they enter Maharashtra. 2. The RT-PCR sample collection should have been done within 96 hours before the scheduled arrival in Maharashtra. 3. Passengers not having the RT-PCR test negative report shall be screened for symptoms and body temperature at the alighting railway stations. 4. The passengers without symptoms would be allowed to go on to their destination. 5. Passengers who display symptoms shall be segregated and made to undergo Antigen Test. If the Antigen test becomes negative, the passengers will be allowed to go on to their destination. 6. Passengers not testing/found Covid positive, shall be sent to Covid Care Centre (CCC) for further care. The cost of further care including CCC shall be borne by the passenger themselves. 7. The concerned Municipal Commissioners/District Collectors will be the Nodal Officers for the same and ensure that the above instructions are followed strictly. <p><u>Road Travel</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The concerned District Collectors of land border districts shall make arrangements to ensure that the passengers coming from the NCR Delhi, States of Rajasthan, Gujarat and Goa shall be tested for symptoms including body temperature. 2. The passengers without symptoms will be allowed entry. Passengers with symptoms shall have the option of turning back and go to their home to recuperate. 3. Passengers who display symptoms shall be segregated and made to undergo Antigen Test. If the Antigen test comes negative, the passengers will be allowed to travel further into Maharashtra. 4. Passengers not testing/found Covid positive shall be sent to Covid Care Centre (CCC) for further care. The cost of further care including CCC shall be borne by the passenger themselves.
