ANDHRA PRADESH	Sterling Palavelli Godaveri	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No separate permission/e-pass required to enter Andhra Pradesh. 14 days of quarantine is not required for people coming from other locations. All the District Collectors are directed to randomly screen all the passengers coming from other states through trains in the railway stations before they exit the station. Similar procedure have to be followed for passengers coming from other states through buses at bus stations. All the District Collectors of the districts having international airports and sea ports are directed to screen all the international arrivals at the point of entry itself duly screening them with thermal scanners and to collect the samples for COVID testing. 	
HIMACHAL PRADESH	Sterling Dharamshala Sterling Kufri Sterling Manali	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> E-registration is not required from 1st July 2021. Social outdoor gatherings are allowed maximum 100 persons. 	
JAMMU & KASHMIR	Sterling De Laila Houseboats Srinagar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> RTPCR report needed, if not then traveller will be asked to do test at the check post as per protocol. There shall be no restrictions on entry of passengers, returnees or travelers coming to Jammu & Kashmir, whether by road, rail or air. However, they will have to compulsorily undergo a COVID-19 antigen test through any of the prescribed methods as per the protocol of the Government of JBK. The protocol for management of COVID positive persons will be followed for all positive cases.

JAMMU & KASHMIR	Sterling De Laila Houseboats Srinagar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ All restaurants including in hotels, can operate for home delivery, take away and dine-in at 100 percent capacity. ▪ Hotels and hospitality services, can operate at 100% (full) capacity, subject to the SOP of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, dated 4" June, 2020, with particular focus on: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Full protection gear and equipment should be provided to Hotel staff. b) Details of guests with entire travel history to be maintained. c) Only Room service of food should be done instead of in dine-in restaurants. d) Frequent sanitization of common areas and spaces to be done. e) Necessary health precautions for guests and staff. ▪ Intra-district movement of individuals in vehicles is allowed. ▪ Intra-district public passenger transport vehicles, running on routes (buses, mini-buses and maxi-cabs) can operate, by any operator, at full capacity, on routes to be notified by the Transport Department. ▪ Inter-district public passenger transport vehicles (buses and mini-buses only and not maxi-cabs) can operate between Red Districts at full capacity, by JKSRTC only on routes to be notified by the Transport Department. All inter-district public passenger transport vehicles (buses and mini-buses and not maxicabs) can operate between Green and Orange districts at full seating capacity on all routes. ▪ Taxi and Cab aggregators and Maxi-cabs are permitted to ply only within the district, or between Green and Orange districts only.

Shall register in e-Jagratha portal. ▪ b. All domestic travellers irrespective of vaccination status shall undergo SARS CoV - 2 RT PCR test either within 48 hours prior to entering the state or immediately after entering the state of Kerala. ▪ c. Those undertaking RTPCR test on arrival shall be in room isolation at their respective places of stay till RT PCR report is available. ▪ d. If RT PCR test is positive, patient shall seek medical attention from health institution. ▪ e. If RT PCR test is negative, the person shall follow strict universal masking, safe distancing and hand hygiene during their stay in Kerala. If they develop symptoms (fever, cough, sore throat, breathlessness, muscle pain, fatigability, anosmia, diarrhoea) during their stay in Kerala, they shall seek medical attention immediately. ▪ f. Those who do not undergo RT PCR testing will have to remain in room isolation for 14 days from date of entry to Kerala and do self-observation regarding symptoms. MAHARASHTRA	Sterling Lonavala	<p><u>Domestic Air Travel</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All domestic passengers travelling from airports in NCR DELHI, States of Rajasthan, Gujarat and Goa shall carry RT_PCR negative test report with them before boarding and show it at the airport. The Airports Authority of India is requested to check for the report before allowing the passengers to board the flight. 2. The RT-PCR sample collection should have been done within 72 hours of scheduled time of landing at Airports in Maharashtra. 3. Passengers NOT having the RT-PCR test reports fulfilling conditions above in 1 and 2, shall compulsorily undergo RT-PCR test at the concerned airports, at their own cost. The Airport shall arrange the testing centres and charge the passengers directly for testing. 4. Only after undertaking the test, the passengers will be allowed to go to their destination by Airport Operator. The Contact information and address shall be collected from all passengers who undergo tests at airport by Airport Operator to facilitate contact, in case the test report comes positive. 5. Passengers whose report comes positive will be contacted and treated as per existing protocol. 6. The concerned Municipal Commissioners will be the Nodal Officers for the same and ensure that the above instructions are followed strictly.

MAHARASHTRA	Sterling Lonavala	<p><u>Railways</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. All passengers travelling to Maharashtra by trains originating or having halt/stop at stations in the NCR Delhi, States of Rajasthan, Gujarat and Goa shall carry with them RT-PCR negative test report before they enter Maharashtra. 2. The RT-PCR sample collection should have been done within 96 hours before the scheduled arrival in Maharashtra. 3. Passengers not having the RT-PCR test negative report shall be screened for symptoms and body temperature at the alighting railway stations. 4. The passengers without symptoms would be allowed to go on to their destination. 5. Passengers who display symptoms shall be segregated and made to undergo Antigen Test. If the Antigen test becomes negative, the passengers will be allowed to go on to their destination. 6. Passengers not testing/found Covid positive, shall be sent to Covid Care Centre (CCC) for further care. The cost of further care including CCC shall be borne by the passenger themselves. 7. The concerned Municipal Commissioners/District Collectors will be the Nodal Officers for the same and ensure that the above instructions are followed strictly. <p><u>Road Travel</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The concerned District Collectors of land border districts shall make arrangements to ensure that the passengers coming from the NCR Delhi, States of Rajasthan, Gujarat and Goa shall be tested for symptoms including body temperature. 2. The passengers without symptoms will be allowed entry. Passengers with symptoms shall have the option of turning back and go to their home to recuperate. 3. Passengers who display symptoms shall be segregated and made to undergo Antigen Test. If the Antigen test comes negative, the passengers will be allowed to travel further into Maharashtra. 4. Passengers not testing/found Covid positive shall be sent to Covid Care Centre (CCC) for further care. The cost of further care including CCC shall be borne by the passenger themselves.

ODISHA	Sterling Puri	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Anyone travelling to Odisha from any other state has to carry RT PCR test report (taken 72 Hours before arrival) or final vaccination certificate after two doses of vaccination. ▪ Weekend curfew in force from Friday 5 pm to Monday 6 am. ▪ No non-resident guest allowed in the restaurant ▪ Wedding is permitted up to 25 person including staff. Permission required from SDM for the wedding with the complete list of people at the venue. ▪ Apart from the wedding no other social events (Birthday, anniversary etc.) are allowed in hotel premises. ▪ No Social/ Cultural/ Political/ religious/ Academic meetings/ congregations shall be allowed. ▪ Taxi/Cab/Auto rickshaw shall be allowed to operate with driver and two passengers. ▪ Night curfew from 21:00 Hrs to 05:00 Hrs from 17th April. ▪ Jagannath temple closed till July 25. ▪ Restaurants to be closed by 21:00 Hrs. ▪ Temple closed on weekends.

Home delivery will be allowed till 10 pm while take away services is permitted from Monday to Saturday between 6 am to 4 pm, the order said. ▪ No wedding ceremonies will be permitted till June 30 ▪ Swimming pools are closed
